Yearbook

The focus of the class will be on writing, design, and photography.

I will treat this class as a high-level production class. Students will be trained to use CS5, which includes Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign, which are all professional publication programs. After some basic instruction, students will be assigned specific pages for the yearbook that they will be responsible for designing, laying out, writing copy, and securing pictures for. Most class days will be spent with them working to create those pages in a timely manner

Grades will be divided into the standard 80% Summative 20% Formative breakdown. While working on the yearbook, the Formative grades will be based mostly on participation—is the student working toward meeting their specific deadlines, and smaller parts of the process: theme ideas, interview questions, etc. The Summative portion will be made up of grades for finished pages.

<u>Outside requirements:</u> Mondays from 4:25 to 6:00 p.m. are a required work night for all editors. Other staffers are welcome and encouraged to come work on their pages at that time.
